David Horowitz was one of the founders of the New Left in the 1960s and an editor of its most influential magazine, *Ramparts*. He is the author, with Peter Collier, of a number of bestselling dynastic biographies on the Rockefellers, the Kennedys, the Fords, and the Roosevelts, and *Destructive Generation* (1989), a chronicle of their break with the 1960s Left.

Among Horowitz's more recent books are: Radical Son (1997), a memoir tracing his odyssey from "red-diaper baby" to conservative activist, which George Gilder described as "the first great autobiography of his generation"; Uncivil Wars (2002), which chronicles his crusade against intolerance and racial McCarthyism on college campuses; The Professors: the 101 Most Dangerous Academics in America (2006), which reveals a shocking culture of academic corruption; Indoctrination U., a searing look at political indoctrination in our nation's classrooms; Party of Defeat, a summary of how the left wing of the Democratic Party is sabotaging the war effort; One Party Classroom, which shows how radical professors indoctrinate students in America's top colleges; and his latest book is Reforming Our Universities.

In 1988, Horowitz created the Center for the Study of Popular Culture to institutionalize his campaigns against the Left and its anti-American agendas. In July 2006, it was renamed the David Horowitz Freedom Center. The Center's mission is to defend the principles of individual freedom, the rule of law, private property, and limited government. The Center is supported by 70,000 contributors and publishes FrontPageMagazine.com, an online magazine featuring "news of the war at home and abroad." Another Center website, DiscoverTheNetworks.org, is an encyclopedia of the political Left and its networks – the most comprehensive documentation of the active left ever compiled.

In 2003, Horowitz devised an Academic Bill of Rights to protect students from abusive professors. In the same year Horowitz founded Students for Academic Freedom, which now has chapters on 200 college campuses. Since its inception in July of 2003, in three years Horowitz's campaign for academic freedom has been able to make intellectual diversity and academic freedom prominent issues on college campuses across the nation. In 2007, he added the Terrorism Awareness Project to the Freedom Center's agenda. This Project has organized three Islamo Fascism Awareness Weeks on hundreds of university campuses, the largest demonstrations ever by conservative college students.

David Horowitz has spoken at over 300 colleges and universities and continues to visit more than 30 campuses a year. He has appeared on *Nightline, Crossfire, Today, Hannity and Colmes, the O'Reilly Factor, Glenn Beck, Good Morning America, C-SPAN, CNBC, Fox News Channel and MSNBC.*
